Each day volunteers pick up and deliver food items such as bread, muffins, cookies, cakes, pies, along with occasional dairy & toiletry items to those who could use a little help with a never ending grocery bill.



We never know what or how much food that God will give us on any specific day to bless you with, but He has always proven faithful and His children's needs are always met.

As a responsible Non-Profit Corporation we have committed to a 90 / 10 model for spending. We spend 90% of what we receive directly on the programs we support and only 10% is used for administration.
